Important Notice

The Australian Government has issued a compulsory recall notice for all vehicles fitted with defective airbags manufactured by Takata. The compulsory recall notice has been issued as a result of evidence showing the defective Takata airbags pose a significant safety risk for drivers and passengers with the potential to cause serious injury or even death.

Which vehicles are impacted?

The compulsory recall affects around 2.3 million vehicles across a number of different vehicle makes, models and years. To see if your vehicle is on the current recall list, please go to the Australian Competition & Consumer Commission's [Product Safety Australia Takata airbag recall](#) page, which is continually being updated as more information becomes available.

What do I do?

We encourage you to check the current recall list to see if your car, motorcycle or truck is affected and take the relevant advice and action offered by Product Safety Australia. This may include booking an immediate airbag replacement with your dealer or manufacturer or, in the event of 'alpha' airbags being identified, not driving the vehicle at all.
